AMERY FARMERS MARKET RULES - 2003

As a community service, the Amery Community Club is sponsoring a Farmers Market this year.

INTRODUCTION: Admission of the Amery Farmers Market is to provide a broad, diverse selection of quality produce and products to the buyers in and around the City of Amery. It is the purpose of the Amery Farmers Market not to limit products based upon origin or type, other than for safety or health reasons which we decide based upon the discretion of the Market Manager, and/or the rules as stated here.

RULES OF THE MARKET:

- 1). The Farmers Market will be held every Monday from June 1 through October 1, from 4:00 p.m., to 6:00 p.m., at the Soo Line Park in Amery.
- 2). Vendors may arrive early, but no selling will be permitted before 4:00 p.m.
- 3). The market area is up to the Market Manager's discretion. Vendors may choose their own location within the area, on a first come first serve basis.
- 4). The Market Manager will collect fees at a rate of \$5.00 per day, or \$30.00 per season. The \$30.00 seasonal rate shall be paid no later than the second time a vendor sets up. In the event that a vendor does not pay the \$30.00 fee by the second time they set up, then they will be charged \$5.00 per day for the remainder of the season when they set up. Make your check payable to the Amery Community Club.
- 5). The Department of Agriculture rules require that items be sold by item, or lot, NOT by weight since home scales are not always accurate.
- 6). Vendors must keep their sales area clean, and clean up all refuse after each day's sales.
- 7). The Market Manager this year is Tammy Winchell - 268-2473. Please call if you have any questions.

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PERMITTED ITEMS:

- 1). Homegrown fruits, vegetables, herbs and other products.
- 2). Baked goods and other non-perishables. If you hold a retail license, you can sell maple syrup and honey produced by a vendor and properly labeled.
- 3). If you hold a retail license you can sell eggs produced by the vendor as long as they are properly chilled and marked ungraded.
- 4). Natural crafts raised or gathered by the vendor, such as dried arrangements, wreaths or herbal crafts.
- 5). Plants and flowers grown by the vendor.
- 6). Meat produced and processed by a licensed establishment and also subject to a retail license.

THERE ARE NO RESTRICTIONS IN SELLING REGARDLESS OF WHETHER THE VENDOR GREW THE PRODUCTS THEMSELVES, OR ALTERNATIVELY WHETHER THE VENDOR IS A RESELLER AS LONG AS THE PRODUCT IS NOT UNSAFE AND/OR UNHEALTHY.

The Amery Community Club and its Market Managers are not responsible for any accidents, injuries, vendor custom or transactions. All issues or disputes shall first be addressed to the Amery Farmers Market Manager, (Tammy Winchell), and then in turn to the Amery Community Club, if necessary and appropriate.
