

## *Simple Rules of the Greenwood/Loyal Farmers Market*

- 1) The Greenwood Market will be on Wednesdays from 2 PM to approximately 6 PM. The Loyal Market will be on Saturdays from 8 AM to approximately 12 PM. Please be set up by the start time.*
- 2) The market hopes that vendors will sell as much of their own produce and products as possible. Please feel free to indicate your home grown items with labels or signs. Ask about the free "Grown in Clark County" labels -- available while supplies last.*
- 3) All canned and baked goods must come from a licensed kitchen. Vendors selling any other foods that require state licenses will need to obtain one. Proof of the license will have to be provided to the market treasurer. All sampling of products must meet state codes.*
- 4) Vendor fees are \$5 per day or \$50 for the season. The season will run from June 2 through October 31. If you choose the \$50 fee, this will cover you for both markets. This fee covers the market's \$1 million liability insurance policy, city licensing fees, and any advertising.*
- 5) Clean up after yourself. The lots are not ours, let's keep them clean. Repeated lack of clean up will result in additional vendor costs.*
- 6) The market reserves the right to refuse vendor space due to misconduct or violation of state law.*
- 7) The market wishes all to have profitable sales and an enjoyable time. If a problem arises, please bring it to the attention of Larry Eggman at the market or home 255-9830. He can also be reached at N8466 Cardinal Ave. Loyal, WI 54446.*
